

# WEST SACRAMENTO DEEP-WATER CHANNEL RECREATIONAL TRAIL



SIGNAGE, PAVING AND PLANTING ARE THE MOST IMPORTANT ASPECTS TO THIS DESIGN. THE AREA IS ALREADY IN USE. THE OBJECTIVE IS TO ENHANCE AND CREATE A NATURAL ENVIRONMENT USING AS MUCH OF THE EXISTING LANDSCAPE AS POSSIBLE. THE USER WILL BE A GUEST IN THE ENVIRONMENT. THIS PROJECT'S CONCEPT IS TO CREATE A PASSIVE RECREATION TRAIL ON THE DEEP-WATER CHANNEL LEVEE. DIFFERENT TYPES OF PLANTS AND TREES ALREADY IMBUE THIS SECTION OF LEVEE. THE MOST NOTICEABLE IS A LARGE POPULATION OF BIRCH.

BOTH ENTRANCES WILL BE DESIGNED AS SMALL PARKS TO WELCOME AND PROMOTE RECREATION IN THE AREA.

THE RECENT INCREASE IN RESIDENTIAL HOUSING IN THE WEST SACRAMENTO AREA IS IN NEED OF A BEAUTIFUL RECREATIONAL AREA THAT EMBRACES THE COMMUNITY AND PROVIDES NATURAL WILDLIFE ENVIRONMENT. LOCAL RESIDENTS CURRENTLY USE THE LEVEE (ABOVE) AND SURROUNDING ENVIRONMENT FOR PASSIVE RECREATION ACTIVITIES. THE PROJECT'S FOCUS IS ON THE AREA LOCATED BETWEEN MARSHALL RD. IN THE SOUTH PORT AREA, AND FINISHES AT THE NORTHERN END OF JEFFERSON BLVD. THE NEW ENVIRONMENT WILL OFFER SPACE FOR THE COMMUNITY TO ENJOY NATURE A VARIETY OF WAYS. WATCHING THE NATURAL WILDLIFE, HAVING PICNICS BY THE CHANNEL, WALKS, JOGS, AND BIKE RIDES ARE A FEW OF THE ACTIVITIES THAT MAY BE ENJOYED AFTER IMPROVEMENTS ARE MADE. THE LEVEE IS CURRENTLY GRAVEL WHICH MAKES ACCESSIBILITY LIMITED. THE LAND SURROUNDING THE LEVEE IS IN NEED OF RESTORATION.



SOUTH PORT ENTRANCE
