## INTERSECTION REPAIR

### Intersection repair is:

The process of painting the intersection with a mural that reflects the culture of the neighborhood.



### The benefits of intersection repair are:

Increased safety because the paintings highlight the intersection and cross walk. Also the creation of a sense of place at the intersection improves community interaction by creating a meeting area that everyone must work together to create.

## Design Suggestions

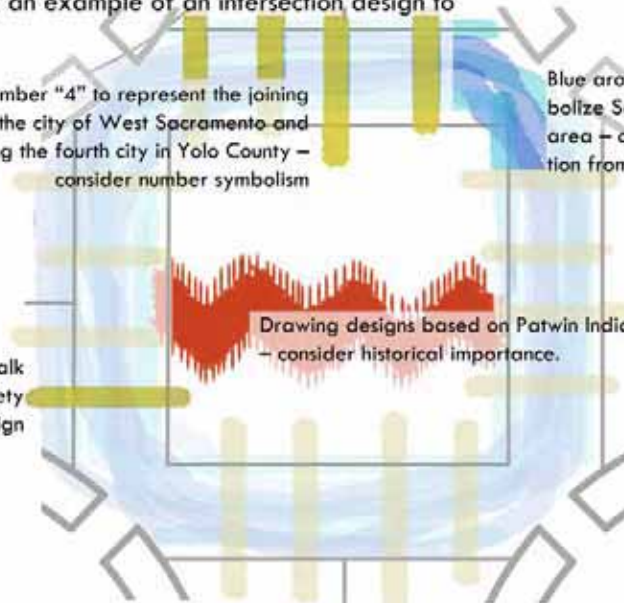
I intend this intersection to be a blank canvas for the neighborhood to design on, but I have created an example of an intersection design to show some suggestions.

The repetition of the number "4" to represent the joining of four towns to create the city of West Sacramento and West Sacramento being the fourth city in Yolo County – consider number symbolism

Blue around the crosswalks to symbolize Sacramento River and port area – consider drawing inspiration from surrounding area.

The use of stripes across the crosswalk to highlight that area- consider safety when creating your design

Drawing designs based on Patwin Indian basket design – consider historical importance.

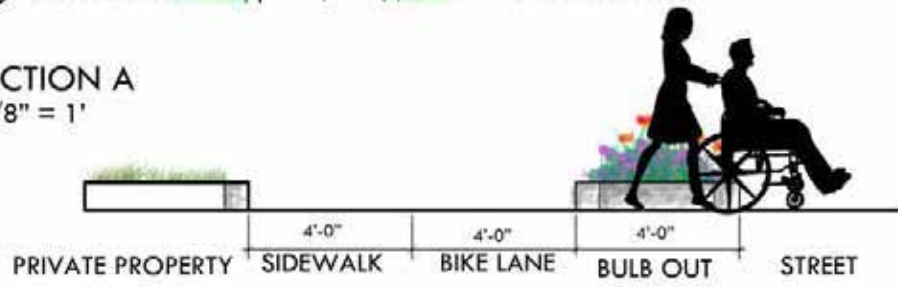

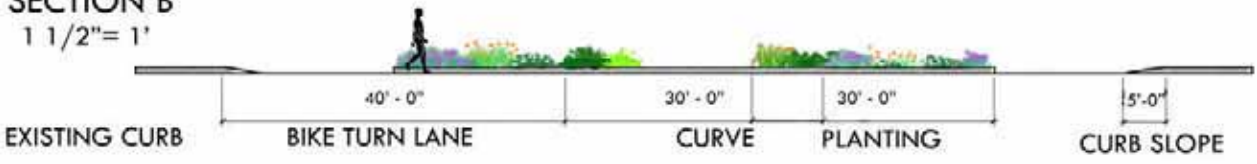
