Caution ~ Beware of these obstacles

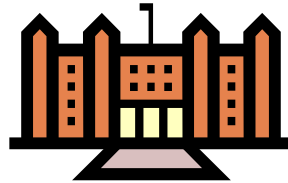
The takeover and its cousin, Pet project syndrome (1-2 people dominate and make it their project, not our project)

Misplaced reliance on institutions,
loss of community ownership



Narrow Inclusion (not reaching out and inviting in people who are

traditionally excluded or ‘labeled’)



Outreach for tasks instead of inviting people into “ownership” of project
