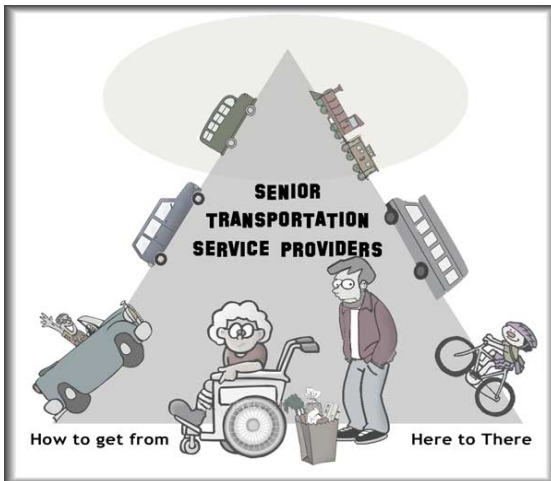

- **YOLOBUS (Yolo County Transportation District)**

The Yolo County Transportation District (YCTD) administers YOLOBUS, which operates local and intercity bus service 365 days a year in Yolo County and neighboring areas. YOLOBUS serves Davis, West Sacramento, Winters, Woodland, downtown Sacramento, Sacramento International Airport, Cache Creek Casino Resort, Esparto, Madison, Dunnigan and Knights Landing. As an added convenience for our riders, YOLOBUS makes connections with other local public transportation systems. With connections to Unitrans and Fairfield-SuisunTransit in Davis, and Regional Transit and Light Rail in Sacramento, you have a wide range of options. Please use the number listed above for fare, route and schedule information.

All YOLOBUS fixed-route buses are accessible to people with disabilities as is required by the American with Disabilities Act (ADA). The YCTD also provides complementary paratransit service, which is door-to-door and lift equipped transportation service, through the YOLOBUS Special program. YOLOBUS Special rides are available to residents with a qualifying disability under ADA and West Sacramento residents who are 62 years of age or older. Ride requests may be made one to five days in advance, but no later than 6:00 PM one day before your ride. Please use the number listed above to request an application and schedule a ride.

- **City of Sacramento, Parks & Recreation Department Shuttle**

The Senior Center provides transportation to and from the Elderly Nutrition Program Tuesday through Friday with pick-ups times between 9:00 and 10:00 AM and drop-off times are after lunch. Shopping shuttle service is provided on Fridays with pickup times for the first trip starting at approximately 8:00 AM and pickups for the second trip starting at approximately 10:00 AM. Shuttle service to Wal-mart is provided the second Monday of the month (pickups begin at 8:00 AM and drop-offs start at 11:00 AM) and the second Friday of each month (pick-ups beginning at 1:00 PM and drop-offs beginning at 3:30 PM).
