Beginning at 9 am Arborists will train city residents & students on tree care & pruning as part of the hands-on program to review the 400 new street trees planted over the last three years. Youth wanting community service credit can get 12 hours for attending all three days- (just show up) and earn 4 or even 7 extra hours helping a neighbor plant a free city tree. Alternately, hours can be earned by helping with door to door fliering for new trees after the tree care events.
