Dear General Potter,
 The Postal Service may decide to close our historic branch post office, the Bryte Station at 1548 Lisbon Ave., Bryte, CA. 95605, in 2010. Twelve to fifteen years ago, a promise was made by the Western Regional Director to keep this post office open. Since then, policies and procedures have changed in the branch, which have resulted in inconvenient hours and low postal supplies. This has forced more and more customers away from the branch. Our neighborhood is full of seniors, limited English-speakers, and socially isolated individuals who rely on this post office as their only contact with families, neighbors and their native countries.

The Bryte Station was considered to be a vibrant, vital service to this community in the past. We urge you to give us a fair and equitable chance to retain our postal history by instituting at least a three year trial period in which our hours and stamp quotas are returned to their former full day status, and all product quota restrictions are lifted.
